Research Assistant Positions Available

The Library seeks law students to participate in the Library Faculty Research Assistant Program this summer. Full time and part time positions are available. Students selected will conduct research for VLS faculty members while receiving training and supervision from reference librarians. Students will benefit from having the opportunity to work closely with faculty members on a variety of projects while, at the same time, sharpening their research skills.

Preference will be given to students showing solid academic achievement, demonstrated attention to detail, and strong interpersonal and communications skills to work effectively with faculty and staff. Some faculty projects require RAs with particular substantive, technical or language skills.

Hours:

Flexible; must be able to meet with faculty members and librarians periodically throughout the summer; Positions begin May 29, 2012.

Pay:

Must be Work-Study eligible. Rate: \$9.50/hr.
